Nativity School will have a 12:00 Noon dismissal on Wednesday, April 12th. There will be **NO AFTERSCHOOL** on this day.


Nativity School will be closed for Easter break from Thursday, April 13th through Sunday, April 23rd. School will reopen on Monday, April 24th.
